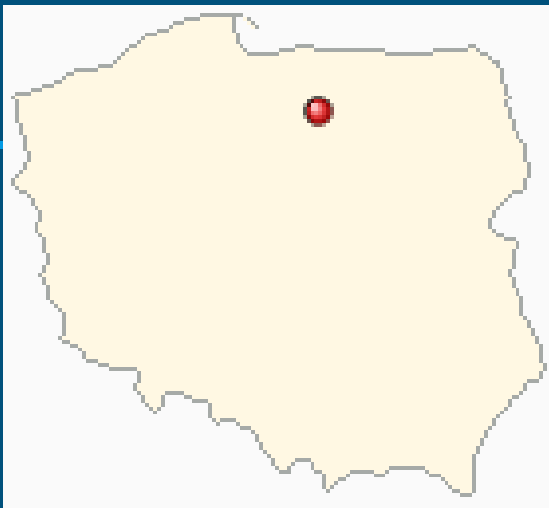

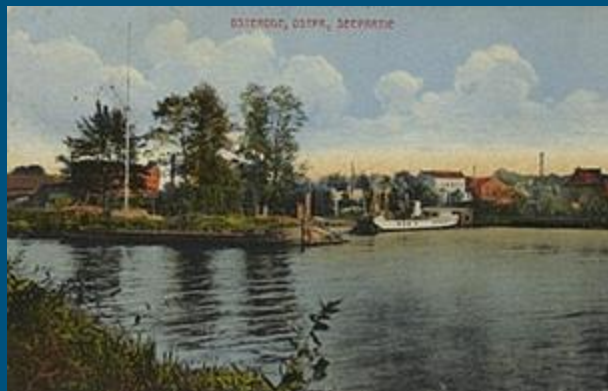


My city Ostróda





The city is located in the Warmian-Masurian Voivodeship. It is surrounded by a large number of lakes, rivers and forests. It has 33,000 inhabitants.

What to see

Teutonic castle

The brick castle was located in the north-western part of the city, from which it was separated by an external defensive wall and a moat powered by a branch of the Drwęża River. Construction of the castle begins 1350-1370.



Lake "Drwęckie"

One of the greatest attractions of Ostróda and the surrounding area is Lake "Drwęckie". Its area is approximately 880 hectares and its depth exceeds 22 meters. Not the entire lake is located in the Ostróda area, but it is on its shore that the city life takes place.



Pier in Ostróda

One of the largest inland piers in Poland is located in Ostróda on Lake Drwęckie. The central point of the pier is an octagonal gazebo with a stage, where live music concerts take place in the summer season. There are also benches, and the whole area is illuminated, so you can visit it during the day and at night. Right next to it there is a popular restaurant serving Czech cuisine and beer.



Promenade in Ostróda

The favorite place for walks among residents and tourists is the promenade at the shore of Lake Drwęckie. You will find the most popular restaurants, cafes and many attractions there. The whole area is very well-kept and well-kept, with lots of lawns and flower beds. There are also benches and even comfortable deckchairs, so it is an ideal place not only for a walk, but also for relaxation.



Elbląg Canal

Navigable waterway in the Warmian-Masurian Voivodeship. In 1978, a section of the canal was recognized as a technical monument, and in 2011 it was recognized as a historical monument. In 2007, in the "Rzeczpospolita" plebiscite, the Elbląg Canal was recognized as one of the seven wonders of Poland.



Amphitheater

Located on the eastern shore of Lake Drwęckie. The amphitheater's auditorium has 2,500 seats. It hosts music concerts, theater performances, all kinds of presentations, cabarets and other mass events.



Ostróda Reggae Festival

Ostróda Reggae Festival is the largest event of this type in Poland. It has been held in Ostróda in the summer since 2001, so for 20 years. This is the leading Polish event presenting music and culture originating from Jamaica.



The football stadium

The football stadium consists of a main football pitch, a training pitch with a synthetic grass surface and a two-story building with covered stands for almost 5,000 seats. .Right next to the football stadium there are tennis courts, a climbing wall and a pump track with a mini ramp or mini go-karts.
